### HOT SUMMER SHOWS!

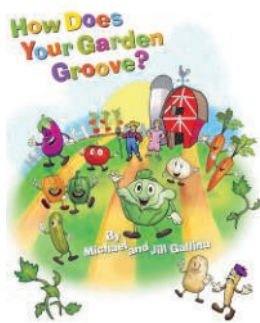


Here is a sneak peak at the shows we will be doing at camps this summer

#### TEEN TRAINING, ages 12 to 18 at Oceana will be doing **ONCE ON THIS ISLAND**

One stormy night, thunder booms, making a small girl cry in fear. To comfort her, four storytellers tell her the

story of Ti Moune, a peasant girl who falls in love with a grand homme, Daniel Beauxhomme. A story of life, pain, love, grief, faith, and hope. *Once On This Island* is a captivating legend of romance between a peasant girl and a rich city boy whom she saves from death. This calypso-flavoured re-telling of The Little Mermaid opens on a Caribbean island where villagers comfort a little girl with the story of the orphan Ti Moune, destined to love too much for the human heart to bear.



**BROADWAY BOUND, ages 4 to 7** will be doing *HOW DOES YOUR GARDEN GROOVE?* Freddy and Franny Farmer's garden vegetables are movin' and groovin' in this charming and imaginative mini-musical for primary-age students. This is not your typical garden-variety musical as the french fried potatoes have "appeal,"

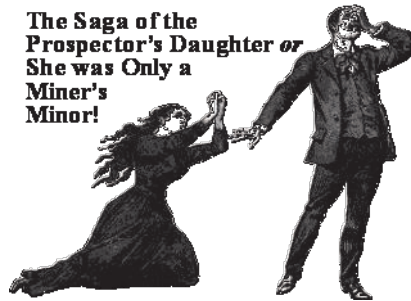
leafy vegetables sing "Lettuce Entertain You" and the corn and peas beg "Please Don't Put Us in a Can-Can!" These lively veggies will sing and dance their way into everyone's hearts!

**SPOTLIGHT STARS** ages 7-12 will be doing *THE ROCKIN' TALE OF SNOW WHITE* The tale of Snow White has never felt so fresh and new with this funny adaptation that will make even the most jaded among us laugh out



loud! New characters and comedic twists come to life as a modern mom reads the Brothers Grimm tale to her restless children. In addition to the well-known cast of the kind princess, evil queen, multiple dwarves and the morally conflicted Huntsman, this musical introduces us to some fresh new faces such as rhyme-happy ladies-in-waiting and a stick-in-the-mud governmental representative out to ruin everyone's good time! (He nabs the Huntsman for attempting to kill a wild pig without a hunting license and fines a dwarf for picking a bouquet of state flowers!) Musical styles of all genres fuse to create a rousing mixture of hip-hop, rock and roll, doo wop and more!

**The Saga of the Prospector's Daughter or She was Only a Miner's Minor!**



**ACTOR'S STUDIO SESSION I, ages 10-18** Lovely, innocent Constance Purdy is about to lose her home to that villain-about-town, Wiley Schlink. Will hero Monroe Mannerly ride to the rescue in time? Will her long-lost prospector father show up and save the day? These ques-

tions aren't really answered because we're laughing too hard at the sheriff who has a mortgage on her own jail, a medicine man who ends up in a dress, and a saloon-smashing suffragette whose ax works great on cuticles. Add a piano player with an attitude and a grizzly old prospector/narrator who'd like a different ending to the play, and you get some idea of folks who populate this fool's gold rush town.

#### **ACTOR'S STUDIO SESSION II, ages 10-18**

Here is our version of the Dumas classic. Young D'Artagnan seeks to become a musketeer, or at least see if that brochure about Paris is true. In the city for less than ten minutes, he finds himself facing all three of the musketeers when they are charged by Rochefort and the Cardinal's Guards. This spoof of seventeenth century France pulls out all the stops and is full of outrageous characters from a lying Cardinal who's into magic to Milady DeWinter who cannot get rid of her mother. Throw in a narrator, several star-crossed lovers, a race on stick horses and a fund-raising telethon and your audience won't know what hit them. Full of fast-paced quips and action.

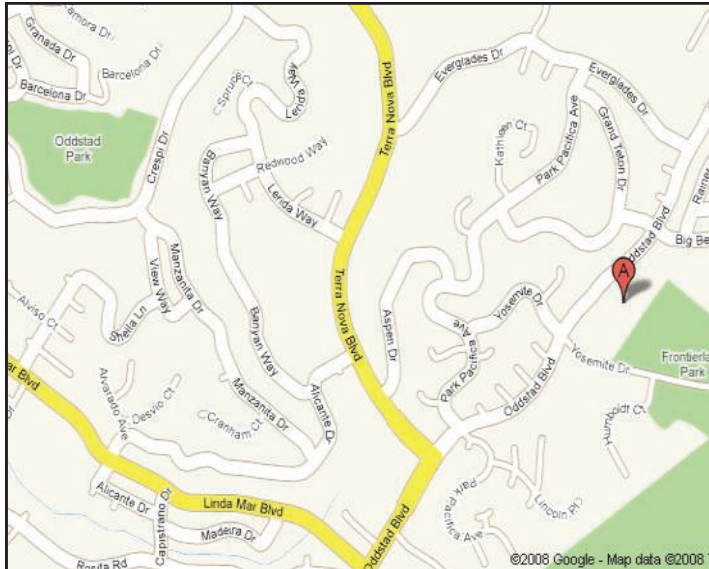

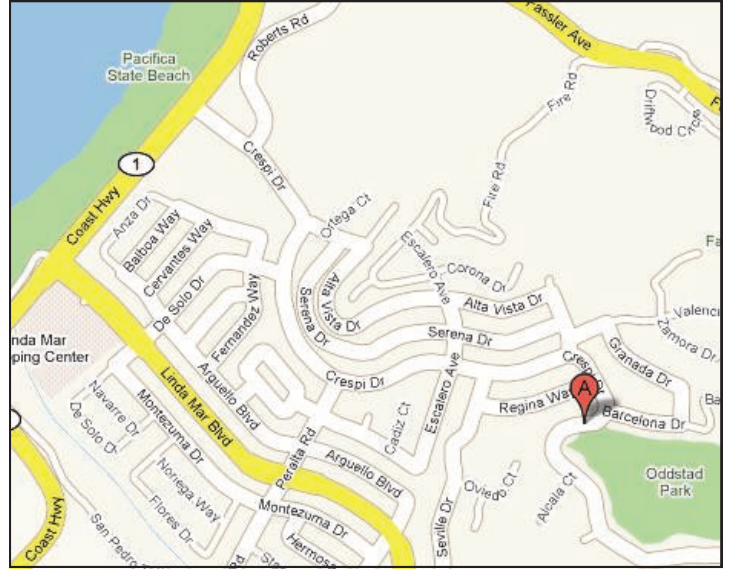
